

# 2. Study programme exams in the second semester

## 2.1 First-year exam: Programming, Systems development, Technology and Business

### 2.1.1 Exam procedure

The project is presented by the project group; duration: 30 minutes maximum. Afterwards, each group member will be tested individually. Exam duration is 30 minutes per student including time for deliberations.

# 3. Study programme exams in the third semester

### 3.1 Programming exam: Programming 2 and Technology 2

### 3.1.1 Exam procedure

For the exam, the student will present a key topic from the project (no longer than 15 minutes). The presentation must include a demonstration of code. Afterwards, each group member will be tested individually.

Exam duration is 40 minutes per student including time for deliberations.

### 3.2 Systems development exam

### 3.2.1 Exam procedure

The exam begins with the student making a presentation taking the systems development report as its starting point. Duration: 10 minutes maximum. This is followed by 20 minutes of exam dialogue and deliberations.

Exam duration is 30 minutes per student including time for deliberations.

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### 4. Exams in the fourth semester

### 4.1 The elective element exam

### 4.1.1 Exam procedure (for elective elements offered by the home institution)

The project is presented by the project group; duration 20 minutes maximum. Afterwards, the whole group is tested together. Exam duration will be 10 minutes per group plus 10 minutes per examinee, however, no more than 45 minutes in total including time for deliberations.

### 4.1.2 Exam procedure (for self-organised elective elements)

The project is presented by the project group; duration 20 minutes maximum. Afterwards, the whole group is tested together. Exam duration will be 10 minutes per group plus 10 minutes per examinee, however, no more than 45 minutes in total including time for deliberations.

# 5. Internship

### 5.1 Exam procedure

The exam begins with the student making a presentation taking the internship as its starting point. Duration: 5 minutes maximum. This is followed by 15 minutes of exam dialogue and deliberations.

Exam duration is 20 minutes per student including time for deliberations.
